### ESTATE-GROWN DRY RED WINE

This wine reflects the heritage of our winemaker who learned winemaking in his native French Beaujolais region. The grapes are grown on the winery hillsides overlooking the Wisconsin River where it develops aromas of fruit with deep berry flavors. Domaine du Sac has a medium bodied palate with overtones of raspberries and dark cherries. Ages five months in French and American oak.

❖ **Grape:** 90% Marechal Foch , 10% Millot, estate-grown Lake Wisconsin Viticultural Area

❖ **Production Method:** semi-carbonic fermentation, Beaujolais method

❖ **Aging:** French and American oak for five months

❖ **Sweetness:** dry

❖ **Alcohol:** 13%

❖ **Serving Temperature:** 55° - 58°

❖ **Ageability:** 2-3 years

❖ **History:** started making Domaine du Sac in 1981
