Domaine Reserve

ESTATE-GROWN DRY RED WINE

Made of fully ripe grapes from thirty-seven year old vines and grown on the steepest slopes of the winery's vineyards. The age of the vines and the excellent exposure give this wine a personality that reflects the "terroir," the specific character imparted by the soil and place it is grown. A traditional fermentation method is used to bring out the spice and berry flavors such as mulberries, blueberries and black currants concentrated in the fruit. A year of aging in oak barrels enhances the depth, finesse, and complexity. A truly unique wine!

The Wollersheim Winery sits on a scenic hillside overlooking the Wisconsin River, just across from Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin. This national historic site was selected by European vintners over 150 years ago and is one of America's oldest winery properties. Established as the Wollersheim Winery in 1972, today the vineyards are comprised of 27 acres of French-American and American hybrid grapes. This regional winery has received numerous Double Gold awards for its premium grape wines and has gained recognition as being one of the leading wineries in the Midwest.
