DRY RED WINE IMPORTED FROM ITALY

Direct from Winemaker Philippe's little brother, Jean-Francois Coquard, who is the winemaker at a small Italian winery, located in the Lombardy region of Northern Italy. Medium-bodied red with aromas reminiscent of eucalyptus, red beets, little berries and notes of almond on the finish. Made from the estate-grown Italian Bonarda grape.

- ❖ **Production Method:** crushed, destemmed, and fermented in stainless steel tanks
- ❖ **Aging:** six months in stainless steel tanks
- ❖ **Sweetness:** dry

The Wollersheim Winery sits on a scenic hillside overlooking the Wisconsin River, just across from Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin. This national historic site was selected by European vintners over 150 years ago and is one of America's oldest winery properties. Established as the Wollersheim Winery in 1972, today the vineyards are comprised of 25 acres of French-American and American hybrid grapes. This regional winery has received numerous Double Gold awards for its premium grape wines and has gained recognition as being one of the leading wineries in the Midwest.
