Bright, fruity and sweet tart with glowing pink color coming from a selection of Foch grapes. This wine makes every sip a memorable tasting experience. Prairie Blush received "Best Blush/Rosé" at the Best of the East Competition in New York in 2007 and has earned Wollersheim Winery the distinction of being one of America's premium rose producers.

❖ **Grape:** 100% Marechal Foch, Wisconsin grown

❖ **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of 1% obtained by stopping fermentation

❖ **Aging:** none, bottled early spring

❖ **Sweetness:** semi-dry

❖ **Alcohol:** 11%

❖ **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°

❖ **Ageability:** enjoy young (up to two years)

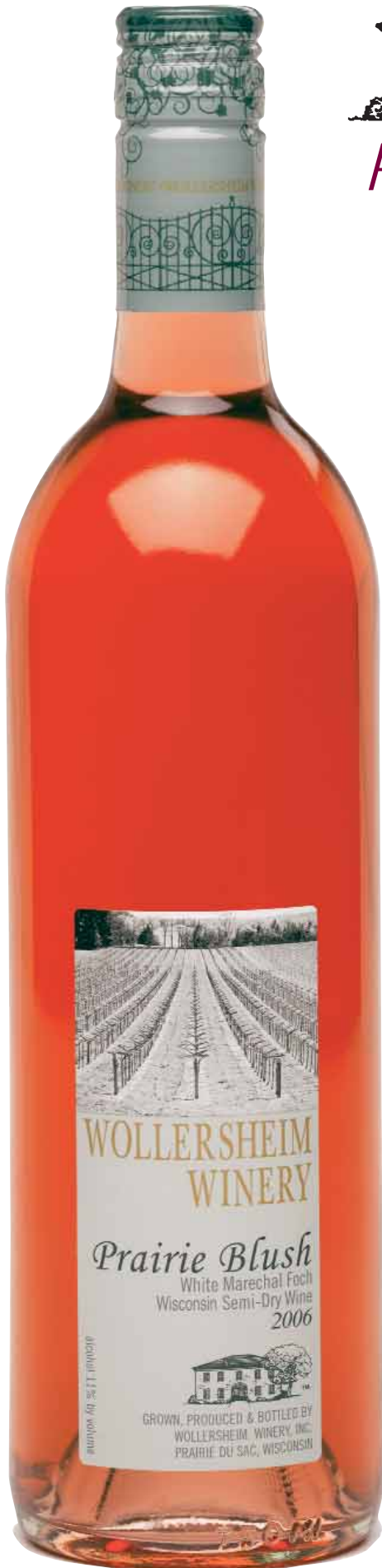
