SEMI-SWEET WHITE WINE

A fragrant white with floral and citrusy aromas of honeyed pears, figs and apricots. An elegant dessert wine. Consistently a "Gold" medal award-winner.

- ❖ **Grape:** 100% White Riesling, custom-grown in Washington state
- ❖ **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of 2.4% obtained by stopping fermentation
- ❖ **Aging:** none, bottled early spring
- ❖ **Sweetness:** semi-sweet
- ❖ **Alcohol:** 10.5%
- ❖ **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°
- ❖ **Ageability:** enjoy young (up to two years)
- ❖ **History:** started making White Riesling in 1986 (originally called Johannisberg Riesling)
